Meeting Convened at 7:10 p.m. with Dave Knox, president of the board presiding. Board members Susan Fitzpatrick and Ron Ebbers were present.

Nineteen property owners were welcomed.

Another member wondered if the Manhattan Project would affect Riviera traffic. It was felt that we are too far west for any traffic problems to arise, but members were encouraged to attend the city meetings and provide their input.
